

Cairo day trip to Luxor by Flight

OVERVIEW

During Cairo day tours to Luxor, you will explore the Valley of the Kings,

Tutankhamun's tomb, Hatshepsut temple, and the Colossi of Memnon on the

Luxor West Bank with Egypt tours. While on the Luxor east bank, you will visit the Karnak temple of Amun and a lot of small temples inside, like the Mut temple, the Khonsu temple, and the Ptah temple. Moreover, Cairo sightseeing tours to Luxor are the best way to learn about ancient Egyptian Civilization, and ancient Egyptian history during the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties of the New Kingdom. Finally, you will always have a chance to add some more attractions like the Valley of the Queens, the Valley of Nobles, the Ramesseum, and the Habu Temple.

ITINERARY

1 Luxor Attractions

Start your one-day tour in Luxor with The Valley of the Kings, is a very famous archaeological site located on Luxor west bank and it was the burial site of the pharaohs from the New Kingdom. Indeed, the Valley of the Kings contains 63 tombs (now even more) for some of the very famous Pharaohs of the Eighteenth Dynasty, Nineteenth Dynasty and Twentieth Dynasty. Among these Pharaohs are Hatshepsut, Thutmose I, Tutankhamun, Ramses II, Seti I, and Tuthmosis III.

Also, you can visit the famous <u>Tutankhamun tomb</u> where they found his golden Mask, Sarcophagi, Canopic Jars, and jewelry. Explore <u>Hatshepsut temple</u> was designed by the architect Senenmut in Deir El Bahari during the 18th dynasty dedicated to God Amun.

The temple shows the ancient Egyptian architecture and why it's a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy visiting The Memnon Colossi, they are impressive example of ancient Egyptian sculpture. These two massive stone statues that depict Pharaoh Amenhotep III seated on the throne once decorated the entrance of hos Mortuary temple. Your guide will explain you why they were called vocal Memnon and the meaning of the mysterious sound at dawn.

Lunch: Enjoy your lunch meal at a local restaurant in Luxor as part of your Egypt tours before you proceed to your last Stop.

Karnak temple

Your <u>Luxor attractions</u> will end with the biggest Pharaonic temple in Egypt.

During your visit to <u>the Karnak temple Complex</u>, you will learn about the history of ancient Egyptian Pharaohs, the Egyptian Gods, and Funerary beliefs in ancient Egypt. Also, the Pharaonic Legends, the Astrology in ancient Egypt, and the Sculpture. At the end of your Egypt tour packages, your guide will join you to Luxor airport to fly back to Cairo. Upon arrival, we will transfer you back to your hotel in Cairo or Giza as part of our Egypt day tours.
