At the end of this amazing Aswan day tours, you will start your back to Aswan to visit [the Aswan High Dam](#) on the way. Actually, the Aswan Dam took 10 years of hard work after the Egyptian revolution of 1952 to control the Nile floods, supply the lands with water for irrigation, and generate hydroelectricity. At the end of your visit to Aswan High Dam, your guide will drive you back to your hotel, Nile Cruise.
