1 Day Kalabsha and Nubian Tour

Kalabsha temple is the second saved temple after Abu Simbel on the west bank of the Nile River. The Kalabsha temple was built on much older Egyptian temple dates back to Thutmose III, Amenophis II, and was completed by Roman Emperor Augustus. After enjoying the visit to Kalabsha temple with the chance to see Aswan High Dam very close and short boat ride, you will head to Nubian Museum. Actually, the Nubian Museum was opened in 1997 to protect and preserve the Nubian history with a lot of antiquities found in Nubia around 3500 B.C. Also, there is a nice section for the Meroitic civilization ruled together with the Greco Roman civilization in Egypt. Finally, the Museum won the prize of Agha Khan as the most beautiful architectural buildings in the world.
