

## Luxor Day Trip from El Gouna

### OVERVIEW

Booking private Luxor tour from El Gouna will allow you to experience Luxor attractions at your own with your private guide with Egypt tours. It is known that

Thebes or Luxor was the capital of Egypt during the New Kingdom for 500 years. Meanwhile, Luxor has amazing Pharaonic temples and Pharaonic tombs on both banks of the Nile River with Egypt day tours. Egypt daily tours from El Gouna will allow you to visit Tutankhamun tomb and some more tombs like the tomb of King Ramses V, tomb of King Ramesses I, tomb of King Ramesses X, tomb of King Ramesses XI, and the tomb of King Ramesses III. Also, from El Gouna day tours, you will love the Pharaonic reliefs on the walls of the Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut especially Anubis Chapel and Hathor Chapel. In addition, the biggest temple in the world Karnak temple and all the small temples inside like Ptah temple, Festival Hall of Thutmose III, Khonsu temple, Barque shrine of Ramesses III, and Osiris Chapel. Furthermore, you will marvel the massive statues of Amenhotep III known as Memnon Colossi.

## ITINERARY

### 1 Day Luxor Top Sites

Your [Luxor day tours](#) from El Gouna starts early morning at the lobby of your hotel when meeting your guide. The distance from El Gouna to Luxor is around 300 km takes four hours driving. Once, you arrived Luxor, you will start with the east bank of the Nile River. Start your trip with [Karnak temples complex](#), the temple of Karnak is about 200 acres and it started from the Middle Kingdom till the Roman period. Explore the hidden gems in Karnak like the Red Chapel, White Chapel, Sekhmet Chapel, Karnak Canyon, the Calendar, and Botanical Garden. Once you finish Karnak tour, you will go to enjoy your lunch.

Lunch Meal: enjoy your freshly cooked lunch at a local restaurant with the possibility of vegetarian meals as part of your El Gouna Excursions.

In case if you like to enjoy a 30 minutes short Nile Cruise on the Nile River to enjoy a fresh drink and the fruits of the season against charge. Meanwhile, to see [Luxor temple](#) from the water, Winter palace, typical Egyptian country side along the Nile. After that you will explore [Memnon Colossi](#), these majestic two statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III (1386 - 1349 BC) is a colossal masterpiece that was made in 1350 BC to decorate his Mortuary temple on Luxor west bank. Then go to discover the Valley of the Kings one of the best [attractions in Luxor](#), it located on the west bank of the Nile River. This miraculous Valley has 63 tombs dug underground for the Pharaohs of the Eighteenth Dynasty, Nineteenth Dynasty and Twentieth Dynasty. After visiting your 3 tombs and shoot some photos for the astronomical ceiling of the tombs, you will be ready for your last stop.

[The Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut](#) will be your final spot, it was designed by her engineer Senmut to honor the God Amun (1507 - 1458 BC). It located in Deir El Bahari surround by [the Nobles tombs](#). At the end of your Luxor day tour from El Gouna, you will head back to your hotel.
