OVERVIEW

In your Egypt shore excursions, you can walk around the Pyramid and be so close to the Queen Pyramids, tombs of Pyramid builders, and the boat Pits. Besides, the Panoramic view is from the highest point on the Giza plateau. Also, you will enjoy the Camel rides visit the mummification temple, and learn about the history of the Great Sphinx and the third eye chakra. This Port Said shore excursions to Giza Pyramids are the best things to do in Egypt.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Pyramids Tour

Golavita travel expert tour guide will be waiting with your name on a sign at Port Said Port to start your full-day tour of <u>Cairo attractions</u> such as the Giza Pyramids. You will start your shore excursion tour with one of the seven wonders, the Pyramids of Giza.

Giza Pyramids Complex

The Pyramids of Giza on the Giza plateau are home to the famous three Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Menkaure from the 4th Dynasty, Old Kingdom. These mind-blowing constructions still amazed the historian about their impossible perfection. Moreover, the relationship between the Pyramids and the Orion Belt still needs more studies.

Cheops Pyramid

The Great Pyramid of Cheops is the only surviving wonder of the old wonder. Originally, it was 146 m but now it's only 137 m in height and about 7 million tons in weight. The Great Pyramid includes 3 small Queen Pyramids, Tombs of Pyramid builders, a Purification temple, and 5 boat Pits including the Cheops Solat Boat now in the Grand Egyptian Museum.

Tombs of Pyramid builders

A lot of tombs were discovered in 1990 and later in 2009 for the builders of the Pyramid and seems they were for those who died during the construction. One of the most beautiful discovered tombs was for a couple, Ptah-shepsesu and his wife, with three burial shafts in the tomb. These tombs provide valuable information about the daily life of the low-class people.

Valley Temple

This temple is part of the Pyramid's complex and seems it was used for Mummification or at least performance the Opening of the Mouth rituals. Chephren Valley temple is the best-preserved one in Egypt right now.

The Great Sphinx

The famous Giza Sphinx is a huge statue with a human head and lion body measures 73 meters long and 20 meters in height. Between the paws of <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, you can see the Dream Stele for prince Thutmose IV from the 18th Dynasty, New Kingdom.

Lunch: You will enjoy your lunch at the highest point on the Giza plateau where you can see the 9 Pyramids align. Enjoy the great view while having your coffee

and later on, you will enjoy the Camel ride for half an hour down to Menkaure

Pyramid.
