use the toilet (10 l.e per person) or get a coffee.

Start with [Dendera temple](#) is the best-preserved Pharaonic temple in Egypt and it has unique features comparing to Upper Egypt temples. Here, you will be surprised how advanced they were concerning the architecture in ancient Egypt, and the astronomy in ancient Egypt. Also, the colors and the art of paintings in ancient Egypt was amazing in Dendera temple.

Lunch

: After Dendera temple, we drive you to Luxor for about one hour and half. You will stop first for lunch at a local restaurant with Nile View. Before you cross the Nile River to the west bank.

After having lunch you will visit Valley of the Kings on Luxor west bank one of the best [things to do in Egypt](#) from Safaga Port. There are 63 tombs in the Valley of the Kings (now even more), with your entrance ticket, you can visit 3 tombs and you can shoot photos inside for free. These three tombs could be 3 of the following tombs

- (KV 02) Rameses IV
- Tomb of Ramses III (KV 11)
- Ramses IX Tomb KV 6
- KV15 Seti II
- Siptah KV47
- KV16 Ramesses I
- Merenptah tomb (KV 8)
- The tomb of Tausert and Setnakht (KV 14)

Then go to [Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut](#), The mortuary temple of Hatshepsut starts with the avenue of Sphinxes with only two restorated Sphinxes statues for the Queen. Enjoy [Memnon Colossi](#), These are two very huge twin seated statues

17m in height each decorated the entrance of the Mortuary temple of Amenhotep III during the New Kingdom.
