Day 1 Cairo

[Golavita Travel Egypt](#) representative will greet and assist you through immigration and customs formalities at Cairo airport. Once you are ready, he will join you in our modern new brand vehicle to your hotel in Cairo to check-in, you will enjoy Sound and Light Show at [Giza Pyramids](#). Your guide will join you and your family to enjoy the legendary Pyramids sound and light show to learn about

ancient Egyptian history. Later on, you will take your dinner at a local restaurant where you will taste the Egyptian food.

Day 2 Cairo and Giza

Enjoy your hearty breakfast at the hotel then start your full day guided tour to Giza and [Cairo attractions](#). you will discover Saqqara Necropolis and [Step Pyramid Complex](#). Imhotep the talented engineer of the King Djoser developed the previous Mastaba to a step Pyramid using the stones totally for the first time. Also, the Southern tomb, Serdab are among the highlights of [the Djoser Pyramid](#). Unas Pyramid, another small but amazing Pyramid dates back to the fifth dynasty, king Unas who covers the interior walls of this Pyramid with Pyramid Texts for the first time. There are 227 spells in [the Pyramid of Unas](#) out of 675 in all the Pyramids like Pepy first, Titi, Pepy second.

Lunch: Enjoy your lunch at the foot of Saqqara exit in a very nice restaurant between palm trees.

Giza Pyramids, open your heart and mind and listen to your Egyptologist guide while explaining about the Egyptian Pyramids and the secrets behind building them. While you visit [the Pyramid of Khafre](#), you will know about ancient Egyptian history during the fourth dynasty and the famous Egyptian Pharaohs. [The Great Sphinx](#): Giza Plateau has one Sphinx or more and why? The Great Sphinx you will see is the biggest in Egypt and it was carved onsite. It measures 72 meters in length and 20 meters tall with human head and lion body.

Day 3 Cairo Attractions

Join your guide after breakfast to one of the best [Cairo day tours](#) to marvel some of the top tourist attractions. Start with [the Grand Egyptian Museum](#). The GEM or the Grand Egyptian Museum is the place where you can understand everything about ancient Egyptian civilization. Old Cairo will be your next stop, it is a multi-religious place has the oldest Church in Egypt, the Oldest Synagogue, and the Oldest Mosque. You will explore [Cairo attractions](#) in your tour to Old Cairo will include [the Hanging Church](#) on the southern gate of the Roman Fortress.

Together with Abu Serga Church and the Crypt of the Virgin Mary and Jesus Christ during their stay in Egypt. Besides, Amr Ibn El Ass Mosque, the oldest Islamic Mosque in Egypt. Ben Ezra Synagogue is included in your tour and it is in the place where Moses lived or at least was found in the basket. End your day with [National Museum of Egyptian Civilization](#). The National Museum was built basically to house the royal Mummies of the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom found in Deir El Bahari Cache. Meanwhile, there is a real fishing boats and funerary objects suppose to be in everybody's tomb.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch

Day 4 Aswan - Nile Cruise

Check-out and early morning departure after breakfast to Cairo airport to fly to Aswan. Upon arrival, you will start your guided [Aswan day tours](#), start with High Dam. The purpose of the High Dam was to regulate the flow of Nile flood. Another popular tourist attractions in Aswan on Agilkia island after it was relocated because of the High Dam. [Philae temple](#) is dedicated to Isis, Hathor, Horus, Osiris and it was the last place witnessed the use of Hieroglyphic

language and Hieratic language. [The Unfinished Obelisk](#) in Aswan granite quarries is the biggest in Egypt but not standing. The Obelisk weighs more than 1200 tons, one single piece of stone. A lot of historians believe it was carved during the reign of Hatshepsut but no proof. Once you finish your tour, you will go to check-in at your [Egypt Nile Cruise](#).

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 5 Nile Cruise

Early departure to [Abu Simbel](#) with your breakfast boxes around 04.30 am. It takes 4 hours driving with a break in the middle of the distance where you can use the toilet (10 L.E per person), your breakfast, your morning coffee. Upon arrival, you will start your tour to these amazing two temples by Lake Nasser. The Great temple of Abu Simbel was built by the Great Pharaoh Ramesses II of the 19th dynasty in Nubia south of Aswan to the God Amun, Ptah, Rahorakhty, and Ramesses himself as a god. Then you will back to the Nile Cruise with our [Egypt Nile cruises tour](#) for lunch and sailing towards Kom Ombo.

Kom Ombo is a pharaonic temple built during the Greco Roman period with the same plan of any Egyptian temple. [The temple of Kom Ombo](#) is 55 km to the north of Aswan on the east bank of the Nile. In fact, it is a unique temple as it is the only double temple in Egypt right now built for God Sobek, the crocodile-headed god, and Horus the elder.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 6 Nile Cruise - Edfu

Enjoy your breakfast on board the cruise then visits Horus temple in Edfu with horse carriages.

[Edfu temple](#): Horus temple in Edfu city is the best-preserved Pharaonic temple in Egypt especially Upper Egypt. The temple has very unique reliefs such as the struggle between Horus and Seth, Osiris Myth, the Festival of the Beautiful Reunion, and the Leg of Osiris Myth.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 7 Luxor Attractions

Enjoy your last breakfast on board the Nile Cruise then start your [Luxor attractions](#) to the east and west bank of the Nile River. then you will visit [the Valley of the Kings](#). Once, you are here you can visit Tutankhamun tomb against charge but still three more tombs included in the entrance ticket. At the end of your tour to the top [Luxor attractions](#), you will proceed to the next stop.

[The Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut](#) in Deir El Bahari is a very unique temple in Luxor near by the Mortuary temple of Montohetep II, and the tombs of Nobles. It was dedicated to Amun, Hathor, Anubis, Osiris and Khanum. Discover why Thutmose III destroyed all the Queen figures and left gods figures. [Colossi of Memnon](#): Memo Colossi are the second biggest after Ramesses the great statues in Abu Simbel about 17m height and 720 tons each.

Lunch: Enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant

After lunch you will go to [Karnak temple](#), it is a unique temple on the east bank of Luxor dedicated to the Triad of Luxor during the New Kingdom Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. The temple has a lot of Pylons, shrines, Chapels, Hypostyle Halls, sacred lake and Obelisks. At the end of the day, your guide will join you to

Hurghada to check-in at your Red Sea resort

Day 8 Hurghada

After breakfast at the hotel, your snorkel guide will join you to the luxury yacht to start your full day snorkeling trip to Paradise Island. Enjoy two snorkeling spots where you can explore the Red Sea coral reefs, Red Sea fishes and the Red Sea Marine Life. Spend around 90 minutes on the Paradise Island beach under the umbrella, sunbath, or walk and shoot some nice photos.
